HOW STATEMENTS ARE AMPLIFIED BY BUSINESS FORWARD:

- Issue briefs and other education resources

- Joint testimony to federal agencies during comment periods

HOW TO FORMAT A STATEMENT:

Begin by stating your expertise and credibility as a business leader.

Then, spend
2-3 sentences
explaining how
the issue impacts
your business.

If appropriate, end by stating your support for a specific solution, policy, or piece of legislation.



I've been working in agriculture for 20 years. I own a small farm in northern Michigan.

Since I started in the industry, I've seen rising temperatures, unpredictable weather patterns, and the heightened frequency of heavy rainfall cause volatile crop yields for me and the other farmers in my community.

Climate change has already taken a toll on my bottom line by driving increasingly unreliable revenue streams — and it is threatening jobs, exports, and the competitiveness of U.S. agriculture more broadly.
